



## Quick Guide to Flea Control

### CATS

**Indoor cats, or cats that go outside, do not hunt much and rarely have a problem with fleas.**

- Use Clear Spot On every 5 weeks or a flea collar as a repellent
- Regularly comb your cat with a flea comb
- If you see fleas, treat them with a spot on treatment

**Cats that go outside and hunt, but only rarely have a problem with fleas.**

- Use Clear Spot On every 5 weeks or a flea collar as a repellent
- Regularly comb your cat with a flea comb
- If fleas are seen, then treat with Clear spot on treatment

**Cats which go outside and hunt, and often have a problem with fleas.**

- Use Clear Spot On every 4 weeks
- You should also use a Clear home product to treat the home environment – see application details on the product you use for details on how often to apply
- Alternatively, use Bob Martin Clear Double Action Spot On every 4 weeks to control fleas and prevent larvae hatching in the environment
- Regularly wash the pet's bedding

**For cats that suddenly develop a major flea infestation.**

- Use Bob Martin Clear Flea Tablets to kill all fleas on the animal within 24 hours
- Then use Clear Spot On and a Clear home treatment product
- Alternatively, use Bob Martin Clear Double Action Spot On to prevent the fleas from returning
- Regularly wash the pet's bedding

**For a cat with Flea Allergic Dermatitis (FAD).**

- Use Clear Spot On or Bob Martin Double Action Spot On every 4 weeks
- Comb your cat with a flea comb regularly, and if fleas or dirt are seen, treat the environment as well
- Regularly wash the pet's bedding

**For a pregnant cat.**

- Use Bob Martin Clear Double Action Spot On for prevention and control
- Alternatively, use Bob Martin Clear Flea Tablets to control an immediate infestation

**Is there a pesticide free treatment for my cat?.**

- Use a Neem flea collar as a repellent on your cat
- Also use the Bob Martin Clear Flea & Tick Spray to treat your pet and the environment if fleas are seen

**For a kitten.**

- Clear Spot On and Bob Martin Clear Double Action Spot On can be used from 8 weeks of age
- Bob Martin Clear Flea Tablets can be used in kittens from 4 weeks, as long as they do not weigh less than 1kg

## DOGS

**For dogs that live outside and regularly come into contact with wildlife, but rarely have a problem with fleas.**

- Use Clear Spot On every 8 weeks

**For dogs that live outside, come into contact with wildlife and often have a problem with fleas.**

- Use Clear Spot On every 8 weeks and a Clear home product to treat the environment in and round the kennel.

**How often this needs to be done will depend upon the product used – check the instructions on the packet.**

- Alternatively, use Bob Martin Clear Double Action Spot On every 4 weeks, which will control fleas and prevent larvae hatching in the environment
- Regularly wash the pet's bedding

**For a dog which has suddenly developed a massive flea infestation.**

- Use Bob Martin Clear Flea Tablets which will kill all fleas within 24 hours
- Alternatively, use Bob Martin Clear Flea Shampoo to vastly reduce the initial flea population.
- Then use Clear Spot On every 8 weeks and treat the environment with a Clear home product too, or use Bob Martin Clear Double Action spot on every 4 weeks.
- Shampooed your pet? Wait 48 hours before applying the spot on.
- Wash the pet's bedding.

**For dogs that live in the house and rarely have a problem with fleas.**

- Use Clear Spot On every 8 weeks

**For dogs that live in the house but often have a problem with fleas.**

- Use Clear Spot On every 8 weeks and a Clear home product to treat the environment
- Alternatively, use Bob Martin Clear Double Action spot on every 4 weeks

**For dogs with Flea Allergic Dermatitis (FAD).**

- Use Clear Spot On or Bob Martin Clear Double Action Spot On every 4 weeks
- Comb your dog with a flea comb regularly, and if fleas or dirt are seen treat the environment as well.
- Regularly wash the pet's bedding

**For a pregnant dog.**

- Use Bob Martin Clear Double Action Spot On for prevention and control of fleas
- Alternatively, use Bob Martin Clear Flea Tablets for an immediate infestation

**Is there a pesticide free treatment for my dog?**

- Use Bob Martin Clear Flea & Tick Spray and flea comb to treat the dog and environment

**Puppies.**

- Clear Spot On and Bob Martin Clear Double Action Spot On can be used from 8 weeks of age
- Clear Flea tablets can be used in puppies from 4 weeks as long as they do not weigh less than 1kg
